## **The 13<sup>th</sup> Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macau Power Industry Summit Focuses on AI and High-Quality Energy Development**

The 13<sup>th</sup> Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macau Power Industry Summit was successfully convened in Macao from 15 to 17 June 2026. Hosted by Companhia de Electricidade de Macau - CEM, S.A. (CEM), and co-hosted by CLP Holdings Limited (CLP), China Southern Power Grid Co., Ltd (CSG), and China General Nuclear Power Group (CGN), the summit carried the theme “Artificial Intelligence (AI) and High-Quality Energy Development”. More than 70 senior representatives from the four companies attended the summit.

Against the backdrop of an evolving global energy landscape, representatives from participating companies, industry experts, and guests held in-depth discussions on the application of AI and development pathways to advance the energy transition, aiming to empower high-quality development and regional collaboration through technological innovation.

CLP Holdings Chief Executive Officer Mr T.K. Chiang said in his opening speech, “CLP has fully integrated AI into its digital development blueprint, spanning the entire value chain of operation, customer service, and employee empowerment. We strive to transform AI technology into momentum for business growth. We remain committed to the responsible use of AI, underpinned by principles of transparency, accountability, fairness, and privacy protection, building a robust AI governance framework that aligns with the expectations and values of the society.”

Mr Chiang added, “In the energy transition journey, CLP actively promotes the deep integration of AI technology with Hong Kong’s strategic positioning, and fully supports Hong Kong’s role as a ‘super connector’ and a ‘super value-adder’ to facilitate the alignment of advanced energy technologies from the Chinese Mainland with global markets so that more ‘Chinese Solutions’ can be introduced to support the international energy transformation.”

2026 marks the inaugural year of China’s 15<sup>th</sup> Five-Year Plan period, and also the launch of Hong Kong’s first five-year plan. On 15 June, the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) Government launched the public consultation on The First Five-Year Plan for

Economic and Social Development of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (2026-2030), which sets out clear initiatives including actively aligning with the nation's "dual-carbon" goals, pursuing the long-term target of net-zero power generation, and implementing the "AI+" initiative to promote the deep integration of AI with various industries.

As a company rooted in Hong Kong for 125 years, CLP fully supports the decarbonisation, AI and other development directions proposed in the public consultation document of the HKSAR Government's Five-Year Plan, leveraging its power expertise to enable Hong Kong to align with national strategies and seize emerging opportunities, while driving the deep integration of AI and the energy industry.

CLP has co-organised the Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macau Power Industry Summit with CSG, CGN, and CEM since 2011 to enhance communication and collaboration between the four power companies and promote development within the power industry, contributing to the growth of the Greater Bay Area with reliable energy for regional economic and social development.
